- Presenting in classes;
- Speaking at student organization meetings;
- Representing WLC on social media;
- Developing strategies to increase the number of WLC students;
- Organizing social events and other activities with the WLC honor societies and language clubs.

Upon successful completion of a one year-term, each Language Ambassador will receive a certificate lauding their service to and leadership role in the WLC Program, along with a letter of appreciation suitable for inclusion in the student's professional dossier.
