Returning Official/Scorekeeper:	Someone who has worked with our staff within the last twelve calendar months. Returners are given roster precedence for employment and do not need to attend a new officials meeting/apply for a position; simply attend training clinics.	
New Official/Scorekeeper:	Someone who has not worked with our staff before, OR has not worked with a within the last twelve calendar months. Must submit an application and interview for a position, even scorekeepers, prior to attending training clinics.	sr
Introduction Meetings:	 Introduction to the positions and a chance for us to meet you/you to meet us! We will review the position descriptions, expectations, employment paperwor and upcoming/available opportunities for employment. Only need to attend one (1) of the following meetings listed. These meetings are not intended for returning staff or anyone who has already applied/interviewed for a spot. Please note these meetings are not always offered, as it depends on the numb of staff we have and if someone has already applied for a position with Intramural Sports. <u>Again, prospective staff members only need to attend one of these meetings.</u> Options are available because we are possibly always looking to hire, depending on returning staff members and the number of registered teams.

Attendance/interest early in the semester generally makes a prospective/new staff member eligible for employment for the entire semester. Attendance later in the semester means we can hire you starting the second quarter of the semester. We do look for individuals who are looking to work multiple activities throughout the academic year because a single activity season may only last 5-7 weeks.

Employment paperwork can be submitted any time by contact Matt Schneider at SchneideMD30@uww.edu. A paperwork review meeting must be scheduled with Matt if paperwork is not filled out and turned in during a new officials meeting. Paperwork is only required to be submitted once.

When attending a new officials meeting or meeting with Matt, it is recommended you bring your employment documents (i.e. I-9 documents).
