

Advice from FYE to Families: 'Be an Active Spectator'

Student = Primary Participant

- **Encourage:** student to get involved in class and outside of class this is a social and academic transition. Encourage them to seek out resources.
- **Support:** Listen, listen, listen sometimes they just need someone to talk to and vent. And they may experience homesickness, etc. Keep encouraging them to get connected.
- **Challenge:** Challenge students to be their best, advocate for themselves to effectively problem solve and resolve conflict.


