QUICK FACTS – UW-WHITWATER:

- ❖ There are less than 5,000 parking spots on the UW Whitewater campus
- ❖ In the academic year of 2020-21, there were 11,224 students
- ❖ As of Fall 2020 semester there were 1,340 faculty/staff
- ❖ Parking only gets funding through permit sales, parking fine revenues, and metered fees

What My Permit Pays For.....

1. **Debt Service** – Loans derived from the purchase of properties
2. **Capital Projects** – Costs associated with major lot projects, such as resurfacing, replacement or building
3. **Maintenance/Other** – Costs associated with routine lot needs, such as snow plowing, striping or patching
4. **Overhead Charges** – Direct support provided to other UW-Whitewater campus services used by Parking Services
5. **Police Charges** – Direct support provided to the UW-Whitewater Police Department for enforcement and event control
6. **Permanent Salaries** – The salaries paid to the three full-time employees
7. **Student Salaries** – The salaries paid to the 8-10 student employees (3-4 Front Desk, 5-6 CSO's)
8. **Fringe** – Insurance and benefit costs for the three full-time employees
9. **Bus Service** – Contractual costs associated with the UW-Whitewater to Milwaukee bus service
