

The Diversity Leadership Certificate

is designed to allow students across the disciplines to engage in in-depth diversity learning around issues of gender, race, ethnicity, class, sexuality and ability. Geared towards building responsible citizens and reflective professionals, the program provides students an opportunity to further enhance their knowledge and understanding, develop facilitation skills and engage in productive collaborations across differences.

Certificate requirements • To earn the Diversity Leadership Certificate, participants complete the following six requirements and submit them to an E-portfolio.

Coursework

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Conferences

Complete four 3-credit diversityrelated courses. At least two of them need to be at the 300-400 level and you must earn a minimum of a B- in each.

Diversity projects

Submit three artifacts that demonstrate diversity learning. Artifacts can include papers, podcasts, essay exams, poetry, performances, etc.

On-campus or community events

Attend at least six on-campus or community events that reflect learning about the experiences of at least three different identity groups. Present at one diversity-related conference.

Leadership activity

Organize and facilitate at least one diversity-oriented event or engage in meaningful servicelearning activities.

Final essay

Submit a final integrative essay addressing what you believe diversity is and why it is important. Explain how your concept of diversity will make you a better citizen and better equipped to contribute to the professional world.
