Upper Division Course Eligibility

To take upper division business courses (300-400 level) as a business major you must:

- 1. Have finished or be registering for the last courses in the unique and lower division requirements, and communication skills.
- 2. Have earned a combined (transfer and UW-W) GPA of at least 2.8.
- 3. Have earned 54 or more credits.

NOTES:

- Accounting and Information Technology majors start their programming and lower level requirements as freshmen, but can complete the major in four years.
- **Integrated science and Business majors** start taking the science courses required in the major as freshmen and continue through the sophomore year.
- International Business majors are required to take 16 credits of foreign language and three specific courses that count for general education electives and diversity: Political Science general education course, a Religious Studies general education course, and Cross Cultural Communication.
