

Sample 4-Year Plan – Academic Year 2024-2025 Requirements ACCOUNTING MAJOR (BBA)

The 4-year Plan <u>illustrates the course schedule a new freshman</u> could take to complete a degree in 4 years; it is not an official document. Refer to the Academic Advising Report (AAR) for full requirements.

To graduate, business students must have:

- At least 120 credits
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 in the following areas: major requirements, combined transfer and UW-Whitewater GPA, and in all subjects offered by the College of Business and Economics
 - Transfer students may have different CORE requirements than those listed. Refer to your Advising Report for requirements.

Business Core Courses

All business majors are required to take the core business courses listed below. Specific core courses are sometimes recommended in specific semesters; otherwise, you may take them in either semester.

BEINDP 288-Career Information (Prereq: English 102 or English 105)

BEINDP 290-Business Writing (Prereq: English 102 or English 105)

ECON 245-Business Statistics (Prereq: Math 143 or Math 152 or Math 243 or Math 250 or Math 253 or (Math 142 And Math 151))

ITSCM 280-Intro to Information Systems (Prereq: Minimum 24 credits)

MARKETNG 211-Principles of Marketing (Prereq: Minimum 24 credits)

FNBSLW 341-Business & Commercial Law (Prereq: Minimum 60 credits)

<u>FNBSLW 344</u>-Business Finance (Prereq: Account 244 and (Econ 245 Or Stat 342))

ITSCM 306-Intro to Supply Chain Management (Prereq: Minimum 60 credits)

Course prerequisites leading to 'advanced' accounting electives are summarized here, to assist with course sequence selections:

- ACCOUNT 249 (Prereq: 244) → ACCOUNT 351 OR 352 (Prereq: 249) → ACCOUNT 453 (Prereq: 351 OR 352)
- ACCOUNT 249 (Prereq: 244) → ACCOUNT 341 (Prereq: 249) → ACCOUNT 343 (Prereq: 341) → ACCOUNT 461 (Prereq: 343)
- ACCOUNT 249 (Prereq: 244) → ACCOUNT 341 (Prereq: 249) AND 356 (Coreq: 341) → ACCOUNT 466 (Prereq: 356)
- ACCOUNT 249 (Prereq: 244) → ACCOUNT 341 (Prereq: 249) AND 354 (Coreq: 341) → ACCOUNT 465 (Prereq: 341 AND 354) → ACCOUNT 475 (Prereq: 465)

Important <u>Accounting Program</u> Notes:

Account 493 (Accounting Internship) may be taken for 1-12 credits. An accounting major may take a maximum of 3 ACCOUNT courses in a single semester and no more than 9 units of ACCOUNT total. If a student is taking ACCOUNT 493 as their only course in a semester, that course may be taken for up to 12 units. The accounting department recommends that public accounting internships be completed during the spring semester.

The Accounting Department complies with UW-Whitewater's repeat policies. Under these policies an accounting major:

- 1. may repeat an accounting course in which they earned a C- grade or below for grade replacement.
- 2. may not repeat more than two accounting courses without permission from the Accounting Department.
- may not repeat an accounting course if the student has received credit for a higher-level accounting course for which the course to be repeated is a prerequisite or co-requisite. For example, a student who has received credit for <u>ACCOUNT 341</u> may not repeat <u>ACCOUNT 249</u>.
