MARKETNG 211-Principles of Marketing (Prereq: Minimum 24 credits)

### **General Advising Notes**

Students should take Marketing 211, FNBSLW 341, and Management 301 as their first Business Core courses. Students will automatically fulfill their International Requirement with COMM 424. SCIBUS 493 should be taken junior year or the summer before senior year and requires department consent. SCIBUS 485 requires a senior standing and completion of SCIBUS 493.
