**More than 155 years ago, on April 21, 1868,**  
the state's second normal school opened its doors to the  
first class of 48 students and nine faculty members.

A progressive spirit guided the development of the institution as it evolved from a normal school, which trained teachers for one-room schools, to Whitewater State Teachers College (1927), Wisconsin State College-Whitewater (1951), Wisconsin State University-Whitewater (1964) and as a member of the 13 four-year institutions in the University of Wisconsin System (1971), now the Universities of Wisconsin.

Today, UW-Whitewater is a leading comprehensive university serving almost 12,000 full- and part-time students with 61 undergraduate majors, 21 master's degree programs, one doctoral degree and one education specialist degree in the colleges of Arts and Communication, Business and Economics, Education and Professional Studies, Integrated Studies, and Letters and Sciences. The university awards more than 2,650 degrees every year.

Throughout its history, UW-Whitewater has produced graduates who have actively contributed to the growth of the state and nation. Student learning is the paramount focus of the university's programs and services.

The university takes pride in its regional leadership, national presence and global vision. Many of its academic programs are among the best in the country.



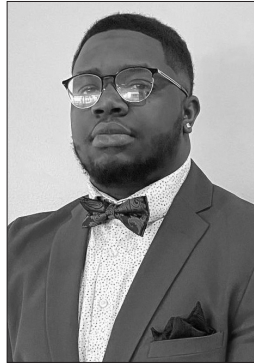

# JORDYN ROBINSON



Growth and perseverance are among the words Milwaukee native Jordyn Robinson uses as he reflects on his undergraduate experience at UW-Whitewater.

“I’ve gained an understanding of what it means to be a professional, what it means to be inclusive, and what it means to think about others outside of yourself,” said Robinson, who is earning a B.A. in journalism with an emphasis in advertising and a minor in sports management.

Robinson said UW-Whitewater helped provide a firm foundation in academics. But he also credits the university, and the myriad people he has met throughout his time on campus, with growing as a person.

“I always tell people that, ‘Yes, I learned a lot in the classroom,’ but I also learned so much more from the student organizations that I’ve been involved in. I’ve learned so much more about the type of person I want to be.”

His involvement included a role as intern at the Warhawk Connection Center. As a manager, he helped coordinate and facilitate 10 or more professional workshop events each semester. He’s also been a part of Whitewater Student Government, where he has served as associate director and, later, director of student affairs, serving as a liaison between students and campus leadership. As an undergraduate, Robinson has earned multiple UW-Whitewater recognitions: the Lucy Baker Involvement Award for two consecutive years and the Mackin Commitment to Diversity Award.

Athletics, long an interest and passion of Robinson’s, have also been at the heart of his imprint on campus life. Early on in his time as an undergraduate, Robinson began coaching in UW-Whitewater’s men’s and women’s basketball programs. He handled such roles as marketing and financial management over a three-and-a-half-year term that ended this past May.

In August of 2022, he founded a company, The GRINDmke, which has a number of components to it, including athletic apparel, sports management, college recruitment and athletic training in the areas of track, football and basketball.

Robinson plans to work full-time after attaining his undergraduate degree. He has further educational aspirations in the form of a master’s degree in communication with an emphasis in strategic communication.

Robinson said he is overcome with gratitude as he looks to his next steps in life. Wherever he goes, he said he aspires to be a positive, inspiring light to other people.

“You really can do anything, when you put your mind into it. It’s all about who you surround yourself with and the rooms that you fight for yourself to be in.” ❖

# MONICA KELSEY-BROWN



In her formative years, Monica Kelsey-Brown had a number of mentors who helped her attain the successes she has achieved throughout her life. In the spirit of giving back, she has a desire to inspire and lead the youth of today as they forge their own paths.

“I want to continue the legacy of supporting students and giving them all that I can give so that they can be successful and find their passion and their pathways as well. That’s my ultimate goal.”

A Milwaukee native, she first came to UW-Whitewater pursuing a degree in management-computer systems, but quickly pivoted to education — in large part because of the guidance and wisdom of her mom, who was her first-grade teacher. On campus, she forged deep ties that included founding the TIFU Cultural Ensemble. She also was a member of the Black Student Union, Alpha Kappa Sorority, Inc. and the Gospel Choir.

A number of UW-Whitewater faculty were instrumental in helping her chart her course as she earned a Bachelor of Science in Education in 1990 and Master of Science in Curriculum and Instruction in 1992. Roger Pulliam, an equity and inclusion champion on campus, was among her mentors.

Over the course of a decade, Kelsey-Brown held a number of different roles on campus. She led such UW-Whitewater initiatives as Upward Bound and the McNair Scholars Program and assumed the role of director of Academic Support Services.

Kelsey-Brown then served in various roles in the School District of Brown Deer over a nine-year span, initially as director of teaching and learning, then as assistant district administrator and, ultimately, superintendent in 2020, making history as the first superintendent of color in a school district that is one of the most diverse in the state. She eventually earned a Doctorate in Curriculum and Instruction and a minor in Educational Philosophy with an emphasis in Multicultural Education from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

In 2023, Kelsey-Brown received the UW-Whitewater Distinguished Alumni Award for Professional Achievement and began a new chapter in her professional life in July 2024 as she assumed the role of superintendent of the Waunakee Community School District. This is her 34th year in education and the fifth year serving as superintendent.

She is not the only member of her family with UW-Whitewater ties, which is all the more reason she continues to have strong bonds to the campus amid her various career milestones.

“UW-Whitewater (...) was a home away from home. It provided all of the support that I did not know was necessary for a person who was identified as a first-generation, low-income student to graduate from UW-Whitewater.” ❖

## UW-WHITewater CEREMONIAL EMBLEMS

---



### THE MACE

A ceremonial staff called a mace is the official symbol of the university that is carried by a university marshal and signifies that ceremonies such as convocations, dedications and commencements have been officially sanctioned. The mace is a gift of the Class of 1969 in recognition of the academic growth of the university. Designed by Kurt J. Matzdorf of New York, the mace is fashioned entirely of sterling silver, enamels and amethyst and represents the School of Graduate Studies and the four of the university's five colleges: Arts and Communication, Business and Economics, Education and Professional Studies, and Letters and Sciences.

The carrier of the ceremonial mace is the W.P. Roseman Excellence in Teaching Award recipient. The award, presented annually to a UW-Whitewater faculty member for outstanding teaching, was established in the memory of W.P. Roseman, who directed the campus elementary school from 1919 to 1942. An all-university committee determines the recipient, and the award carries a cash prize. ❖

### ACADEMIC REGALIA

The cap and gown that faculty and students wear today have a tradition going back to the 12th and 13th centuries, when students and faculty were considered members of the clergy. The bachelor's gown has a closed front and long, pointed sleeves. The master's gown has an open front and extremely long, closed sleeves; the arms protrude through slits at the wrist and the ends of the sleeves are square, with an arc of a circle just above the bottom. The doctor's gown is an open-fronted garment with voluminous bell-shaped sleeves with three black or blue (for philosophy) velvet bars. Gowns are usually black.

The academic hood is edged in colored velvet, which indicates the field in which the degree was earned. The master's hood is three and one-half feet long, with the colors of the edging for degrees granted by UW-Whitewater. The lining of the hood is purple and white, the official academic colors.

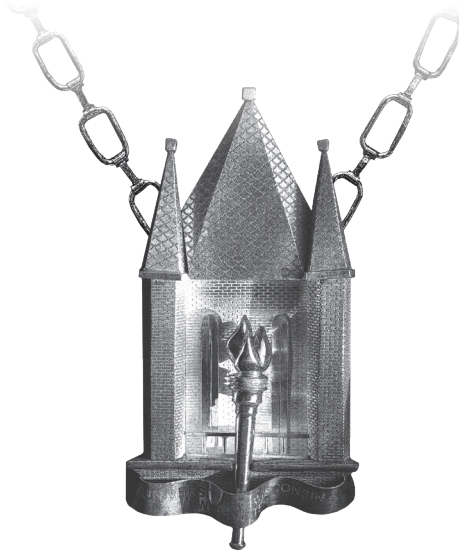
Students wearing gold stoles with "Honor" printed on them are graduates of the University Honors Program. Gold cords designate students graduating with Latin honors (cum laude, magna cum laude and summa cum laude). Some students wear sashes reflecting their participation in student organizations. Graduates who studied abroad or who are affiliated with another country may wear satin sashes reflecting the colors of the country's flag. ❖

### THE CHANCELLOR'S MEDALLION

The chancellor's medallion signifies the history and aspirations of the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater. Conferral upon the chancellor declares that person's institutional leadership role, investing the solemn rights, responsibilities and privileges attendant with that honor.

The medallion depicts the tower of Old Main, the building that served as the centerpiece of the campus from the university's founding in 1868 until it was lost to fire in 1970. The design of artist Linda Threadgill, an emeritus faculty member of the College of Arts and Communication, the medallion was cast and constructed in sterling silver and gold plate. Teresa Faris, professor of art and design, designed and constructed a chain of the same materials for the medallion in 2016.

A gift of the UW-Whitewater Foundation, the medallion was originally presented to Chancellor James R. Connor in 1987. ❖
