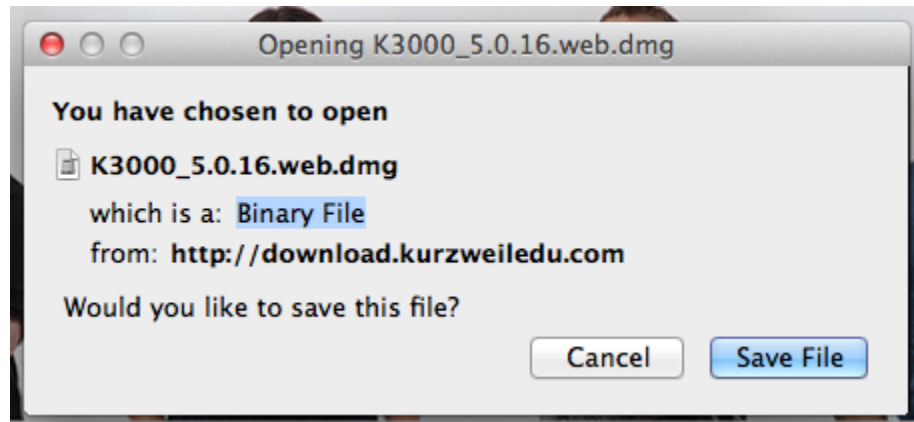


Kurzweil Installation Guide – MAC

This is the installation guide for MAC computers. If you have a PC, please refer to the PC installation guide. You will need to complete these steps after you have received your Kurzweil user name and password, which will be sent to your UW-Whitewater email.

1. Go to the website: www.kurzweiledu.com/installmacv5_OWL-
 - a. You should receive this pop up



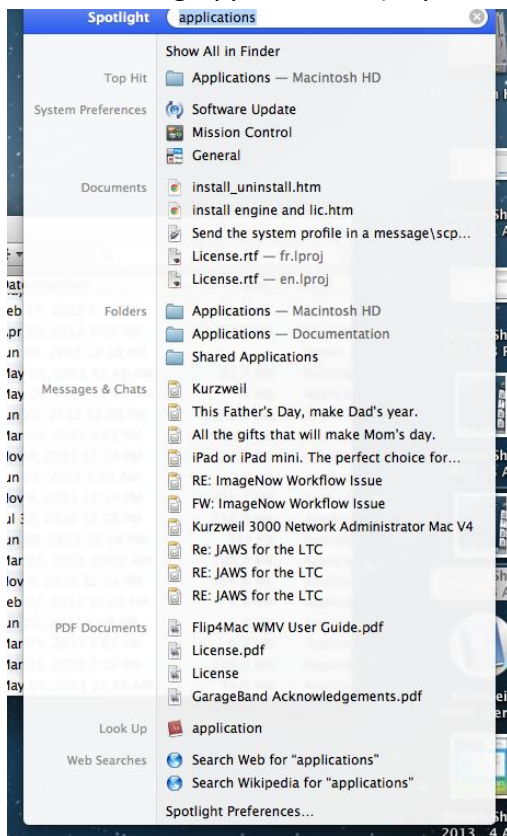
2. Click Save File.
3. Once the download is complete, click on the downloads icon in your dock.
 - a. Once clicked, you should see this:



4. Click on the file K3000_5.0.16.web.dmg
 - a. This will bring up the following window:



5. Open your Applications folder by going to Finder (the magnifying glass in the top right) and searching Applications. (Depicted below)



6. Drag the Kurzweil 3000 Program, shown below, from the screen from step 4 to the applications folder.



- a. This will complete the install of Kurzweil 3000.

Troubleshooting:

You may experience an error when attempting to install the program onto your computer. It will say that the program is not authorized to be installed on your computer. To fix this, you will need to follow these steps: (Please note that you will need to use an administrator account to perform these steps)

1. Open System Preferences. You can do this by opening Finder in the top right corner and searching System. It will be the choice at the top of the list.
2. When the System Preference window comes up, click Security and Privacy in the top row.
3. Once the Security and Privacy window appears, click the lock in the bottom left corner to make changes. (Only do this if the lock appears closed) You may need to enter your accounts password.
4. Under the Allow applications downloaded from:, change the selection to Anywhere. (A pop up will ask you to confirm this change, click Allow from Anywhere)
5. Once you have changed this, click the lock again. This will lock the options in place and will be your normal setting from now on.
6. Attempt the install again.
