

How To Access Notes on HawkNotes

1. First time users must register with Patty Beran at the Center for Students with Disabilities front desk.

2. Once registered, open your internet browser (e.g. Firefox or Internet Explorer) to <http://stori.uww.edu/hawknotes>.



3. Login with your username (campus email address) and your password (Net-ID password).
