2024 Summer Financial Aid Application Directions

Overview:

The summer term consists of classes during several sessions, including 3-week, 6-week, 9-week, and 12-week sessions. Financial Aid for the summer term is awarded separately from the fall 2023 and spring 2024 academic year, and there are some differences in aid eligibility between summer and the academic year. Also, federal grant and loan availability is very limited for summer.

General Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for and awarded federal financial aid for summer, you must meet all the following requirements:

- Have a completed and fully processed 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Be enrolled in courses for the summer term and have submitted this 2024 Summer Application.
- Maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress.

Students who graduate(d) in the spring 2024 term are not eligible for summer financial aid.

Federal Pell Grant Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for and awarded a Federal Pell Grant, you must:

- Meet the general eligibility requirements defined above.
- Be an undergraduate student who has not yet reached the annual 150% of lifetime Pell Grant limit.
- If you were enrolled full-time (12 credits or more) in both fall and spring, you must enroll in 6 credits or more for summer term.
- If you were not enrolled full-time for both fall and spring, you may have limited Pell Grant eligibility if enrolled in at least 1 credit.

Federal Subsidized and Unsubsidized Direct Loan Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for and awarded a Federal Subsidized and/or Unsubsidized Direct Loan, you must:

- Meet the general eligibility requirements defined above.
- Be at half-time enrollment or greater for the summer 2024 term (6 credits or more for Undergraduates and 4.5 credits or more for Graduate students).
- Not already awarded the maximum amount for your grade level during fall 2023/spring 2024. Maximum loan amounts are:

If your grade level will change after spring term, please submit your application after spring grades have been posted.

Additional Notes:

- Summer tuition charges are due June 12, 2024. Tuition is due for all sessions in which you are registered, even if that session starts after the due date and if your financial aid has not yet been applied toward your charges.
- Financial aid will not be applied toward your charges until your earliest session of enrollment (see dates listed on the next page).
- If you drop courses after the summer term has started, or fail to participate, we may be required to reduce or cancel your financial aid which may result in you owing previously awarded financial aid and/or previously issued refunds back to UW-W.
- If you do not meet the requirements as described above, you may want to consider the Parent PLUS Loan, Private Loans, or Graduate PLUS Loan. For directions on how to apply for these loans, please visit http://www.uww.edu/financialaid/types-of-aid/loans. (The Parent PLUS Loan requires undergraduate students to be enrolled in 6 or more credits; the Graduate PLUS Loan requires graduate students to be enrolled in at least 4.5 graduate credits.)
