The online certificate in Dyslexia and Language Based Learning Disabilities (LBLD) prepares professionals with undergraduate degrees in education or related fields to provide intensive reading intervention based on the science of reading. Courses are asynchronous to meet the varied schedules of working professionals. *Participants do not need to have a Wisconsin teaching license to enroll.*

The Dyslexia and Language Based Learning Disabilities certificate coursework is developed to meet all the knowledge and practice standards of the International Dyslexia Association (IDA), including:

- Foundation of Literacy Acquisition
- Knowledge of Diverse Reading Profiles, Including Dyslexia Assessment
- Structured Literacy Instruction (Essential Principles, Phonological and Phonemic Awareness, Phonics and Word Recognition, Automatic and Fluent Reading, Vocabulary, Listening and Reading Comprehension, and Written Expression)
- Professional Dispositions and Practices

Combining with MEd in Special Education:

All of the certificate courses can count toward the master's degree (Professional Development Emphasis). Students can enroll part time or full time.
