The Online Transition Specialist Graduate Certificate prepares educators, independent living professionals, and transition specialists to work effectively with adolescents and young adults in education, independent living, and employment programs. The 15-credit Transition Specialist Online Graduate Certificate:

- Is designed to prepare professionals with bachelor's degrees in education or related fields to facilitate successful school-to-work transition planning for individuals with disabilities.
- Allows students to apply credits earned in the certificate toward UW-Whitewater's Master of Science in Education, Special Education with an emphasis in Professional Development.

Combining with MEd in Special Education:

All of the certificate courses can count toward the master's degree (Professional Development Emphasis). Students can enroll part time or full time.
