The Online Mathematics Graduate Certificate is designed for those individuals who wish to meet credential requirements for teaching undergraduate mathematics courses or those seeking a Master of Science in Education with a Mathematics emphasis.

Admission Requirements

Meet all School of Graduate Studies admission requirements.

Completed at least 24 units of undergraduate mathematics coursework at the level of Calculus I or above with at least a 2.8 GPA.*

*Applicants who do not meet these mathematics coursework requirements may be admitted to the program with a stipulation that they successfully complete two specified math courses in our program (with a B or better) within the first year.
