


# Windows 10 Wired Ethernet Connection Guide


# Step 1.

• Search in startup menu for command prompt and open application.



### Step 2.

• In command prompt type "ipconfig /all" and press Enter.



#### Step 3.

- Under the "Ethernet adapter Ethernet:" heading, you are looking for the Physical Address.
  - o This is the Physical MAC Address that you will need to enter into MyDevices.



#### Step 4.

On another device go to mydevices.uww.edu and log in with your campus NetID and Password.

## Step 5.

• Finally, press "Add" in the upper left hand corner and add your device using the Physical MAC Address you obtained in steps above.
