- Students participating in a study abroad/away program for which you will earn transfer credit – Exchange, Partnership, Direct Enrollment, UW System, and Study Abroad Provider programs—are required to obtain a Transfer Credit Agreement (TCA) prior to departure from UW-Whitewater. The TCA grants approval for study abroad credits to transfer back to UW-Whitewater.
- Academic Residency Requirement: A minimum of 30 units of UWW course
  work is required to qualify for an undergraduate degree. At least 15 of these 30
  units must be taken at UWW immediately prior to graduation. See your
  academic advisor. (See the OGE for the Academic Residency Requirement
  Waiver Request Form)
- Students pursuing any major in the BBA curriculum must complete course work in at least six courses (18-unit minimum) in their major field. A maximum of two transfer courses may count in the BBA major. See your academic advisor
- <u>Students must contact the Advising Coordinators</u> to complete the above
   Transfer Credit Agreement Worksheet to receive academic approval for courses
   abroad. Students must bring the **course descriptions** for their intended courses
   to this meeting.
