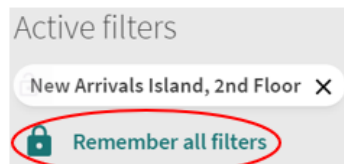

The Library's [Academic Publishing Guide](#) provides resources to guide you in answering the following questions as you seek scholarly publishing opportunities:

- ☆ How can I identify appropriate and reputable journals in my field in which to publish?
- ☆ What are journal impact factors and how can I find them?
- ☆ What about the impact of books?
- ☆ Will my article be easily found by others once published?
- ☆ What considerations are there in seeking to publish in an Open Access journal?
- ☆ What is "predatory publishing"?
- ☆ Journal alerts: Is there any way I can have research on my topic sent directly to me?
- ☆ How can I track the use of my article once published?
- ☆ How can I set up a profile (Google or ORCID) so others can easily track my research?
