Now that UW-Whitewater serves *two libraries*, we are offering a hold service. If you find a Whitewater or Rock County item you want in our catalog, *Sign In*, select *Request* and choose a *Pickup Location* (Whitewater or Rock County) and place your *Local Request*.

That's it—you will receive an email as soon as the item

is ready for pick up—and it will be held for 10 days.

New Article Databases

July, 2019 marked the full integration between Andersen (Whitewater) and Lenox (Rock County) Libraries. We now share a catalog as well as online resources.

Since Rock County subscribed to some databases that Whitewater did not, we've added several of these products to our online repertoire. We now have [JSTOR Arts & Sciences V & VI](#), adding thousands more scholarly articles in many disciplines.

We also have many new [Gale](#) article databases which came as a package with [Opposing Viewpoints in Context](#), a UW Rock County subscription that offers contextual information and opinions on hundreds of today's hottest social issues.

The next time you visit the [Library web site](#), you'll notice a whole new look. The goal of the new design is to make it easier to find what you need. This fall we are making another significant change to our online presence. The Library's eJournals and databases will now require logins to the Library's EZproxy **even** when you are **on campus**. This means that if you are accustomed to using *Google Scholar*, you will no longer **automatically** get access to the Library's content when on a wired campus computer. You will need to login to authenticate using your UW-W netID and password.

If you start your search at the Library web site, you will be prompted to login as needed.

When searching, don't despair—we very likely have what you need—but you may have to login with your netID and password for access.
